## Working with Digital Books from our Site

Our books are available as PDF files and some are available in EPUB and MOBI formats.

#### What is a PDF book?

A PDF, or Portable Document Format, is a file format that captures all elements of a printed book and makes it available using a reader from Adobe and other software providers.

## How do I view a PDF book?

To view a PDF file, you generally need a PDF reader application, or you can use the built-in PDF viewer in your web browser or mobile device. The most common PDF reader is Adobe Acrobat Reader.

## What is a EPUB book?

EPUB is an e-book file format that uses the ".epub" file extension. The term is short for electronic publication and is sometimes stylized as ePUB. EPUB is supported by many ereaders, and compatible software is available for most smartphones, tablets, and computers.

## How do I view a EPUB book?

To view an EPUB book, you'll need an e-reader app or software on your device, or you can use a browser extension to read it directly in the browser. For desktop computers, Adobe Digital Editions, Calibre, and other e-reader software are good options. On mobile devices, Google Play Books, Apple Books, and third-party apps like Moon+ Reader or Aldiko are available.

#### What is a MOBI book?

A .MOBI file is a proprietary ebook format primarily used for Amazon Kindle devices and applications. It was developed by Mobipocket and later adopted by Amazon. MOBI files can be read on Kindle devices and the Kindle apps for various platforms.

## How do I view a MOBI book?

To view a MOBI book, you'll need a MOBI reader. Popular options include the Amazon Kindle app, Calibre, or FBReader. You can also use browser extensions like MOBI Reader.



# How do I access the book that I have purchased?

Regardless of the computer you used to buy the book, MACos or Windows, your will see a receipt on the web page after purchase and an email. Both receipts have a link to the file for download.

## **MACos**

On an Apple computer, the downloaded file typically goes into the Downloads directory. It comes over the internet as a zip file and is automatically unzipped. Select the downloads directory then "Open in Finder" and you will see a file with a PDF, MOBI or EPUB extension. The first part of the filename is the ISBN of the book. It is a good idea to create an ebooks directory and copy the file into that directory so you have a common place for all your ebooks.

## Windows

On a Windows computer, the file is downloaded and appears in the downloads dialog as a .zip file. Select "open file" to unzip it and double click the file to open it with your default reader (by file type). If you have a favorite directory in which to save ebooks, use the save as function of your ebook reader to save the book for future use.
